The school may ask for further supporting evidence if the written documents you provide do not confirm that the child was baptised or received into the Catholic Church (for example, if the name and address of the church is not on the certificate or if the name of the church does not state that it is a Catholic church). If you are having di culty providing written evidence of baptism or reception into the Catholic Church, you should contact your parish priest.

#### B. Evidence of Catholic practice

If you are applying for a place at the school for a Catholic child with a certificate of Catholic practice, the certificate must be signed by a Catholic priest in the form laid down by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. You should get the certificate from your family's parish priest, or the priest in charge of the church where your family practises, and you should send it to the school at the same time as you return this form.

#### C. Evidence for catechumens

If you are applying for a place at the school for a catechumen (someone who is preparing to be received into the Catholic Church), you must provide evidence that they are a member of the catechumenate of a Catholic church.
